Where to Start

- □ Pull everything out of your garage
- Power Purge & sort piles for keep, donate, recycle, repair, and trash
- □ Sweep out entire garage & get rid of cobwebs
- Assess what's left and create zones: shoes near the door, lawn & garden items, sports gear, etc.
- Utilize storage items you own, consider new products that fit your needs
- □ Organize & label items by category
- Dispose of old paint & automotive oil properly

BUZZ Tips

- □ Maximize wall space with shelving & wall systems
- Utilize vertical space: bike hooks are great
- Get items off the floor as much as possible
- Use clear tubs to contain like items & label all
- Consider using pegboards or slat walls for optimal organization
- □ Store rarely used items high & toward the back
- Consider garage cubbies for each member of family for frequently used items
- Use airtight storage containers for pet food
- □ Leave space for trash can & recycling bin

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
